



Client Co-Parenting Divorce Education Classes

Co-Parenting Classes:

Clients must complete the entire pre-registration form. They are required to attend both CAID and TransParenting class.

1. If a protection or no contact order exists, the parent must attend the classes on the dates assigned by DRCB. The assigned dates will be written on the pre-registration form.
2. If you are Hispanic/Latino and have poor English skills, a Spanish pre-registration form and packet of information is available. Client must bring an ADULT interpreter to each class (the interpreter does not have to pay the class fee).
3. If you are outside of St. Joseph County, you need to contact Ann Schelle (TransParenting) for help with locating an equivalent class in your area. The information packet will inform you of the requirement that you complete the online work at www.UpToParents.org. You are to send a copy of the certificate of completion to the Court and a copy to DRCB.
4. The top blue sheet explains each step the client has to take in order to fulfill the Courts' requirements for the mandatory classes. The pink sheet gives more information about the Up To Parents website. The next 2 attachments are the TransParenting and CAID brochure/flyer.
